
CPR FOR THE PROFESSIONAL

The Montecito YMCA offers CPR in January, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, and November.

Professional CPR is designed for life-guards, nurses and other professionals who need to be certified as a job requirement.

Professional CPR is a two-day six hour course. The goal of the class is to educate participants to recognize the symptoms of a heart attack, teach participants how to perform CPR, teach ventilation with a barrier device and use of an automated external defibrillator.

Upon successful completion of the Professional CPR class, participants will receive an American Heart Association Basic Life Support Card (valid for two years).

AED training makes it possible for first aid providers to start early defibrillation. This helps trained personnel arriving on the scene in reviving a patient who has gone into cardiac arrest.

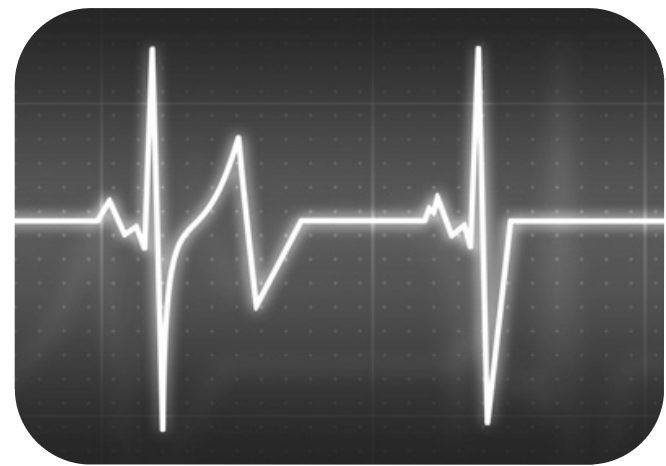
