

SUMMER COUNSELORS/LEADERS -IN-TRAINING

Attention: Those entering 7th - 12th grades this fall...

The YMCA is looking for dedicated, service-oriented teens to join our qualified staff team as Counselors-In-Training or Leaders-In-Training. Enthusiasm, willingness to learn, responsibility and a genuine love for kids are prerequisites for CITs/LITs. They will receive an extensive training program that teaches YMCA values, leadership and communication skills. They will participate in fund raising projects and take part in team building activities including rock climbing and sea kayaking in Morro Bay State Park. Once these skills are developed, CITs/LITs will be able to apply to assist at summer day camp and preschool. This hands-on training will provide valuable job skills that last a lifetime. Most of all, summer will be fun and rewarding.

Training Dates: April 8, 15, 22, 29 and May 6, 13, 2008 - 6:00 - 8:30pm and interviews

These training's are mandatory:

- * CIT/LIT Training in Morro Bay from April 25 – 27th (Rock Climbing/Sea Kayaking)
- * If selected to work during the summer, additional training will include one overnight at the Montecito Family YMCA from May 31st at 1:00pm to June 1st 6:00pm.

Session Dates: June 16 – August 21, 2008 (hands-on-experience)

Cost: Training cost - \$295.00 plus fund raising projects (non-refundable, non-transferable)
Hands on experience - \$695.00 for the summer, if accepted (non-refundable, non-transferable)
