CAMP PAYMENT POLICIES

REGISTRATION: Registrations accepted online at ciymca.org or at the Welcome Center starting March 1, 2012.

DEPOSITS: A deposit is required at the time of registration to reserve space in each session of our camps. All camp deposits are non-refundable.

BALANCES DUE: Remaining fees are due two weeks prior to the beginning of each session (see calendar). Failure to pay on time will result in the loss of your camp deposit and registration for that week. Registrations within two weeks of start date must be paid in full.

CANCELLATIONS/CHANGES/TRANSFERS: All requests must be submitted in writing, no later than two weeks prior to the start of the session. Cancellations two weeks in advance will result in full refund, minus the deposit. If a change in camp registration is granted there will be a \$15 transfer fee for each camper to accommodate supplies and materials for that camper.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: The YMCA offers financial assistance to families who apply and qualify. Applications will be accepted starting March 1 and will be processed in order received.

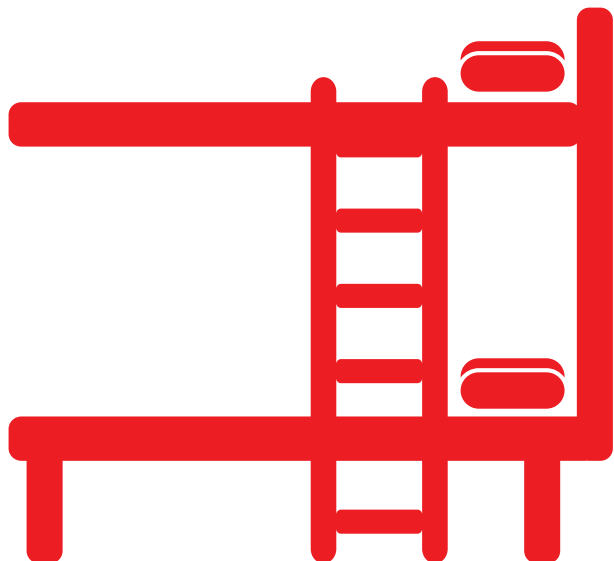
The LIT program at our resident camp is for those experienced campers who haven't had enough and are looking to give back. If your 11th or 12th grader has aged out of camp, but is looking to start transitioning into a leader, the LIT program is for them. The week at camp will include intensive team building and training prior to being placed in a cabin to start as a leader and mentor. The LIT will work closely with the Teen Camp Director to develop leadership skills and techniques for working with youth. Don't think this is happening in the classroom though!
