#### **POLICIES**

#### Membership:

Every member over the age of 12 must have his/her photo on file with the YMCA and must show their valid YMCA access card to enter the YMCA facility. If a member has forgotten their card, they must show a photo ID to be manually checked in. Youth with no photo ID must be accompanied by an adult member that is 18 years of age or over. A Release & Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement must be signed for all Facility Memberships.

#### Nationwide Membership:

By participating in the YMCA Nationwide Membership Program (the "Program"), I agree that Channel Islands YMCA may share my YMCA membership information (e.g. name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, date of birth and membership status) with the National Council of Young Men's Christian Associations of the United States of America and its independent and autonomous member associations in the United States and Puerto Rico (collectively, "Y-USA") for purposes of my participation in the Program.

#### **Membership Cancellation Policy:**

YMCA memberships are billed monthly and will remain active until canceled. You may cancel your membership at any time. If you enrolled online, you may also cancel your membership online. Alternatively, written cancellation requests may be submitted in person at your YMCA location or by email to info@ciymca.org.

Upon cancellation, you will continue to have access to all membership benefits until the end of your current billing cycle. Please note that cancellations are not pro-rated or applied retroactively; the full monthly fee for the current billing period will still be charged.

The terms of the Membership Agreement remain in effect regardless of any changes to your billing, payment method, or membership status. If you cancel your membership while enrolled in a YMCA program, standard program member rates will apply for the remainder of the program.

The YMCA reserves the right to adjust membership fees. In the event of a fee change, members will be provided with at least 30 days' advance notice.

#### **Accounts Receivable:**

It is the responsibility of the member to keep all payments to the YMCA current. If your YMCA account balance becomes more than 60 days past due, your account will be handed over to a 3rd party account management company.

#### **Photographic and Video Release:**

In exchange for good and valuable consideration, the adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, I hereby give Channel Islands YMCA, its volunteers, employees and any other person and entity acting with its permission the right to take, copyright, use, and publish any photographs or video of me or my child/children for the purpose of any YMCA advertising, promotion, or other purpose consistent with the YMCA mission.

I agree that any such photograph or video is the property of the Channel Islands YMCA, and I hereby waive all rights thereto. I further waive any right to inspect or approve any printed or electronic material that may be used in conjunction with the photographs or video, or to approve the use to which the photographs or video may be applied.

#### **Identification and SOR Screening:**

Membership at any Channel Islands YMCA branch requires each individual over the age of 18 to provide at least one legal picture identification at the time of enrollment. Acceptable means of identification are: Drivers License, State Identification Card, Passport, School Identification Card, or Military Identification. At time of membership enrollment, and as needed, a photo of each adult member will be captured and added to the membership record.

The YMCA conducts sex offender screenings. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access.

The YMCA reserves the right to deny access or membership to any person who has been convicted of any crime involving sexual abuse or is, or has been, a registered sex offender. The YMCA reserves the right to conduct background checks on current and prospective members.

#### Channel Islands YMCA Member Code of Conduct

The YMCA is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and welcoming environment for all. We expect people using the YMCA to act maturely, to behave responsibly, and to respect the rights and dignity of others. We expect people to use facilities as they are intended to be used, follow posted guidelines and rules, and adhere to the direction of staff members. Anyone who witnesses behavior that goes against this Code of Conduct is encouraged to report the behavior to a YMCA staff person immediately. We will make every effort to ensure concerns are looked into and addressed promptly.

#### **General Guidelines**

- Check-In: Facility Members are required to scan every visit and have a photo on file.
   Anyone may be asked to show a photo ID upon entry. Identify yourself when asked.
- Reservations: May be required for certain areas or classes.
- Program Only Participants: May only access their specific activity and must arrive and depart after scheduled programming.
- Valuables: Lock up personal items; the YMCA is not responsible for lost/stolen property.
- Equipment Use: Use as intended; return borrowed items in good condition.
- Dress Code: Modest, activity-appropriate attire required. Shirts required in all program areas. Specific rules apply to pools, saunas, and workout areas.
- Service Animals: Only well-behaved and trained service animals are permitted.
- Youth Access:
  - Under 12: Must be under the supervision of an 18+ adult, unless signed into a program. Youth 8-11 may use cardio equipment with an adult member present if the branch offers Kids Cardio Club.
  - 12+: May check into the facility alone and use equipment with some restrictions.
  - 14+: May use free weights.
  - 15+: May use hot tub, sauna, steam room.

#### **Prohibited Behaviors**

- Not following posted signs, rules and staff directions.
- Not utilizing spaces as they were intended, including loitering.
- Harassment, intimidation, or exclusion by words, tone, gestures, body language, or other types of verbally abusive or menacing behavior.
- Physical contact with another person in an angry, aggressive, sexual, unwelcome, or threatening way.
- Soliciting, selling products/services, and unauthorized instruction.
- Theft, vandalism, or possession of weapons.
- Drug/alcohol use or intoxication. Smoking or vaping.
- Unauthorized photography or recording.
- Cell phone use in restricted areas.

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary actions, which may include immediate removal from the premises, loss of privileges, suspension or termination of services. # CHANNEL ISLANDS YMCA MEMBER/CHILDREN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION for being permitted to utilize the facilities, services, and programs of the Channel Islands YMCA (YMCA), and/or for his or her children listed below to so participate for any purpose, including, but not limited to observation or use of facilities or equipment, or participation in any off-site program affiliated with the YMCA, the undersigned, on behalf of himself or herself and such participating children and any personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin (hereinafter referred to as "the undersigned") hereby acknowledges, agrees and represents that he or she has inspected and carefully considered such premises, equipment and facilities and/or the affiliated program and that the undersigned finds and accepts same as being safe and reasonably suited for the use or participation by the undersigned and such participating children.

In addition, the undersigned acknowledges that there is widespread, ongoing transmission of novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") worldwide, including throughout Santa Barbara County and Ventura County, California. In accordance with the most recent (as of the revision date set forth above) orders and recommended quidance and protocols issued by various governmental and public health agencies, including without limitation the World Health Organization (WHO), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department, and the Ventura County Health Care Agency (together, the "Public Health Agencies"), and, with respect to the YMCA's child care facilities, services and programs, the California Department of Social Services (Community Care Licensing Division), for slowing the transmission of COVID-19 (collectively, "COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Guidance"), the undersigned hereby agrees, represents, and warrants that neither the undersigned nor such participating children shall visit or utilize the facilities, services, and programs of the YMCA (other than any exclusively online services and programs) if he or she (i) experiences symptoms of COVID-19, including, without limitation, fever, cough or shortness of breath, or (ii) has a suspected or diagnosed/confirmed case of COVID-19. The undersigned agrees to notify the YMCA immediately if he or she believes that any of the foregoing access/use restrictions may apply.

The YMCA has taken certain steps to implement COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Guidance for slowing the transmission of COVID-19, including, without limitation, the access/use restrictions set forth above, enhanced cleaning and disinfecting protocols, and physical distancing measures. The COVID-19 pandemic is a challenging and fluid situation, and COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Guidance may change frequently. The undersigned acknowledges and agrees that the YMCA may revise its procedures at any time based on updated COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Guidance and further agrees to comply with the YMCA's revised procedures prior to utilizing the facilities, services, and programs of the YMCA. The undersigned further acknowledges and agrees that, due to the nature of the facilities, services, and programs offered by the YMCA, social and physical distancing of 6 feet per person among participants (including children, caregivers and staff) is not possible. The undersigned fully understands and appreciates both the known and potential dangers of utilizing the facilities. services, and programs of the YMCA and acknowledges that use thereof by the undersigned and/or such participating children may, despite the YMCA's reasonable efforts to mitigate such dangers, result in exposure to COVID-19, which could result in quarantine requirements, serious illness, disability, and/or death.

IN FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF BEING PERMITTED TO ENTER THE YMCA FOR ANY PURPOSE INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, OBSERVATION OR USE OF FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT, PARTICIPATION IN ANY ON-SITE OR OFF-SITE PROGRAM AFFILIATED WITH THE YMCA, PARTICIPATION IN ANY VIRTUAL OR ONLINE PROGRAMS, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:

THE UNDERSIGNED, ON HIS OR HER BEHALF AND ON BEHALF OF SUCH PARTICIPATING CHILDREN, HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the YMCA, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers and agents (hereinafter referred to as "Releasees") from all liability to the undersigned or such participating children and all personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin of the undersigned or such participating children for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands on account of any property damage or any injury to, or an illness or the death of, the undersigned or such participating children (or any person who may contract COVID-19 or any other communicable disease, directly or indirectly, from the undersigned or such participating children) whether caused by the negligence, active or passive, of the Releasees or otherwise while the undersigned or such participating children are in, upon, or about the premises or any facilities or equipment therein or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA. The undersigned expressly and knowingly waives all rights under California Civil Code Section 1542, which provides: "A general release does not extend to claims that the creditor or releasing party does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release and that, if known by him or her, would have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor or released party."

THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees, and each of them, from any loss, liability, damages or costs they may incur, whether caused by the negligence, active or passive, of the Releasees or otherwise while the undersigned or any participating child is in, upon, or about the premises or any facilities or equipment therein or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA. The undersigned understands and agrees that the YMCA is not required to provide insurance to cover the undersigned or such participating children in the event they suffer illness, injury, death, property loss, theft or damage of any sort upon, or about the premises or any facilities or equipment therein or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA.

THE UNDERSIGNED agrees and acknowledges that use of the YMCA facilities and services, and participation in the YMCA programs, may involve inherent danger and risk, including, without limitation, the risk of physical illness or injury, death or property damage.

THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
